



Glossary for understanding (passing) Test-1

Unlike most glossaries, this one is not finished. Because we want you to use a print dictionary. Using print dictionary is a good brain exercise such as finding a word in alphabetical order. Besides, reading and writing word definition is an activity that every ESL student needs it. Finally, any print dictionary allows for serendipity.

First, copy words and phrases from [Qualifying Test-1](#) into MS Word DOC file.

Next, arrange all in one column alphabetical order

Then, add square brackets [] to the right of each word

After that, inside square brackets [] keep tally of how many times the word appears in Test-1

Finally, to the right of [] start writing definition in your mother tongue and/or English synonym or definition if you can.

Here are some examples (English - German) of what we expect. Let's assume I am German.

Active [] Aktiv

Active knowledge [] You can recall it and use it.

Complete [2] Ausfüllen

Distinction [] Difference

Knowledge [3] Wissen

Passive knowledge [] Passives wissen
You know when you hear it.

The above explanation, Glossary for Test-1, is for 5% extra bonus , entry #0 in Qualifying Tes-1. It can be used also for 15% extra bonus, entry #60.
